NOTES:

* - Congress adds pots of money to these accounts to be allocated by the Corps after final passage of the appropriations bill by Congress. The House has added over \$30 million for studies of all types of Corps projects. Unlike past years, it has not broken down this overall pot into any subgroups.

** - See the footnote above. The Senate has added \$4,000,000 for Additronal Funds for Studies of Flood and Storm Damage Reduction projects and \$37.276,000 in Additional Funds for construction of Flood and Storm Damage Reduction. Only a portion of these sums go to storm damage reduction projects when Additional Funds are fnally allocated by the Corps. Since there are different figures from the House and Senate for Additional Funds, the final figure will be determined by Congress. *House & Senate Figures are NOT shown in this version of the table*
