Nearly four dozen Democrats voted yes while more than a dozen Republicans opposed the measure. The White House had derided it as a “cynical political maneuver” as Republicans roundly reject a more comprehensive and bipartisan border security-foreign aid deal negotiated in the Senate. In a statement Tuesday Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer reiterated his position that aid for Israel Ukraine and Taiwan should move alongside border security changes.
